EVALUATION PROCEDURE AND GRADING POLICY:

Grades will be determined using the following weights:

Assignments (Addresses objectives 1 through 5)	20%
Participation/Discussion Boards (Addresses objectives 1 through 5)	10%
Case Studies (Addresses objectives 1 through 5)	25%
Quizzes (Addresses objectives 1 through 5)	15%
Exams (Addresses objectives 1 through 5)	30%

LATE ASSIGNMENT POLICY:

Mathematical objectives build on one another. For that reason, due dates are established to ensure that students are able to participate in the next lesson and that instructors can address students' misconceptions. If a student cannot meet a deadline, it is the student's responsibility to contact the instructor ahead of time, requesting an extension.
