## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides an overview of the legal process and an introduction to the **hegal**calissues nurses face in their clinical practice. Information and concepts discussed in this course will provide nurses with information on risk management, patient advocacy strategies, legal nurse principle, and practices that will positively impact the health care delivery system.

Attorney Work- Product & other related assignments (All Objectives) 35% Students will develop attorney-work product in various formats. Students will be exposed to a variety of workproduct styles and will be expected to integrate legal concepts into the assignments. This assignment offers the student the opportunity to demonstrate integration of cognitive skills and critical reasoning. The completed reports will include a worksheet and assigned attornework product.

Weekly Discussion Boards: Topic Scenario (All objectives) 30% Students will be presented with a weekly legal scenario for review and will be given a question related to the scenario requiring student responses in the discussion board. Students are expected to post at least three times weekly and provide well-formulated responses. This discussion will require students engage in an ongoing dialogue with the instructor and fellow students. Attention to problem solving in an ethical manner will be evaluated.
